Argentina Vintage Bottle

101 Masi Tupungato, Pinot Grigio/Torrontes, Passo Blanco **2022** **33**

An organic Argentinian wine made with Italian flair. The Passo Blanco displays aromas of flowers and ripe fruit, peaches and dried apricots. The palate is fruity and refreshing with good acidity and hints of lemon. Made with the classic Pinot Grigio which grapes are slightly dried to concentrate the sugars and the aromatic Torrontes, this blend is truly special.

Austria

102 Rudi Pichler, Grüner Veltliner Federspiel **2022** **54**

An Austrian classic! Notes of citrus, green apple and stone fruits. Well balanced acidity leading to a spicy, lively wine with beautiful minerality and elegance.

Australia

103 Deakin Estate, Chardonnay, Victoria **2021** **28**

An easy going classic Australian Chardonnay, juicy notes of peach and lemon blossom, a creamy slather of vanilla with a crisp refreshing finish.

104 Langmeil Wattle Brae, Dry Riesling, Eden Valley **2022** **43**

A zippy dry riesling that displays zesty lime and tropical fruits. Granny smith apples sing together with the lime and the floral blossom.

105 Protero "Aromatico", Adelaide Hills **2022** **55**

A lovely Australian take on a Northern Italian blend made with 71% Gewürztraminer, 27% Riesling and 2% Sauvignon Blanc. With aromatic notes of Rose, Citrus and Freshly baked yeasty bread this wine is brought together to have a clean long finish.

Croatia

106 Matošević Alba, Malvazija Istarka, Istria **2022** **45**

Made from 100% local Istrian Malvazija grapes, this wine has a pronounced golden colour with delicate aromas of green apple, white peach, and wildflowers. The palate is refreshing with flavours of citrus, honey, and minerals, balanced by a crisp acidity and a long finish.

107 Domaine Luc Pirlet, Sauvignon Blanc, Languedoc **2019** **27**

Light bodied, fresh and well-balanced. This easy drinking white displays aromas of citrus with hints of blackcurrant and gooseberries.

<i>Hailing from a third-generation winemaker, this Sancerre house was established in 1927. You will find notes of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.</i>		
112 Domaine Chantelain, Pouilly-Fumé, Sauvignon Blanc	2019	51
<i>Notes of citrus fruits and exotic fruits (lemon, pink grapefruit, pineapple) as well as mineral aromas (flint) typical of the appellation. The mouth is very round with exotic and mineral notes, associated with a very nice and long finish.</i>		
113 Domaine Hamelin, Chablis 1er Cru, Vau Ligneau	2022	60
<i>This wine is an overachiever, it shows the captivating mineral quality in the palate that true Chablis should have. It is both fleshy and full while retaining fresh orchid fruit and a zesty finish.</i>		
114 Michel Bouzereau, Mersault, Les Grands Charrons	2019	97
<i>Refined, delicate Meursault showing smoky, nutty aromas, and then a powerful, citrusy palate. Bright and invigorating – a great example of the modern Meursault style.</i>		
115 Xavier Monnet, Mersault 1er cru, Les Charmes	2021	178
<i>Swirls of smoke and caramelized honey accent white blossom and pear in this fresh-fruited, zesty but opulent white. Tart pineapple and lemon flavors pierce on the midpalate but finish with a delicate kiss of vanilla.</i>

127 Dog Point, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough **2022** **44**

A complex, multi-dimensional and instantly appealing nose with aromas of limes, grapefruit, crushed sage and positive notes of gunflint and struck-match. An elegant, serious style - dry, taut, and vinous, with a pleasing texture, smokey greengage flavours, zesty acidity and a long, satisfying finish.

128 Cloudy Bay, Sauvignon Blanc **2020** **55**

Classic, pungent, herbaceous bouquet of pink grapefruit, tropical fruit, apple and fresh herbs. Equally urgent on the palate, with high acidity and flavours of passion fruit, pineapple, basil, white peach, hay and stony minerality. Fresh, crunchy texture and a lengthy finish.

Rosé Wines

181 Domaine Luc Pirlet Rosé, Syrah, Languedoc **2022** **28**

A pale-pink colour, this rosé offers extremely faint scents of white flowers, melon rind and orange. The palate is light and breezy, with super soft red-fruit and citrus flavours. It's easy to drink, with final hints of cranberry and orange zest.

182 Lady A, Château La Coste, Provence **2023** **40**

This is a delicious, thirst quenching rose - yet delicate and elegant. Pale in colour, it is light, crisp and zesty, offering flavours of citrus, pink grapefruit, peach and raspberry with a long and refreshing finish.

183 Caves D'Esclans, Whispering Angel, Provence **2023** **48**

Nectarine, white strawberry and yellow raspberries fill the nose, along with cherry blossoms and jasmine. The palate is clean, bright, and sleek with a wet-stone component and a gorgeous juicy yellow plum note, followed by a fresh, clean finish that makes this rosé such a joy to drink.

184 Château Rose, Château La Coste, Provence **2023** **54**

Beautiful pale peach-coloured dress. Complex bouquet combining citrus fruits, peach, pear, and exotic fruits. Beautiful volumes in the mouth, fat, round. Beautiful balance with a refreshing bitter finish.

185 Terre del Noce Mezzacorona, Pinot Grigio Blush **2020** **28**

The appealing pale blush colour of this wine is obtained from the skins of the Pinot Grigio grapes which are pink in colour. A fresh and fruity wine with a delicate flavour and an off-dry finish.

<i>An organic Argentinian wine made with Italian flair. Passo Doble is an aromatic red wine blend of Malbec (85%) and Corvina Veronese (15%). This wine has intense fruitiness and delicious spiciness. The big structure of the wine comes from the Malbec and the vibrant fruitiness comes from the Corvina grapes which are lightly dried, just like they are in Italy.</i>		
202 Pulenta Estate, Malbec I, Mendoza	2020	50
<i>A classic Malbec that is very smooth and well balanced. With intense flavours of red fruits such as strawberries and cherries this wine comes together with delicate sweet spices that come from the oak ageing, showing a wine with great character and structure.</i>		
203 Pulenta Estate Gran Corte VII, Mendoza	2018	74
<i>On the nose the wine reveals elegant notes of raspberry, wild strawberry, cocoa and rosemary. The palate is medium bodied with supple tannins. The fruit profile is red rather than black, with a smooth, harmonious texture and attractive notes of cedar and dried orange peel on the finish.</i>

204 Morandé Pionero Reserva, Pinot Noir	2021	27
<i>A pure and elegant Pinot Noir with notes of raspberry and gentle spice on the nose. The palate is light and silky in texture, allowing the beautiful summer fruit flavours to shine through.</i>		
205 Matetic Carrolo, Carménère, Colchagua	2019	42
<i>Fragrant and lively, with red berry fruit and hibiscus alongside mocha notes. The classic spice and herbaceous character of this grape come through discreetly on the palate with a smooth and easy-going finish that remains rich in fruit.</i>

207 Domaine Cauvard, Chorey-lès-Beaune	2020	58
<i>Three-generations of wine-growing experience is behind this wine. Domaine Cauvard, a family business, has 17 hectares of vines spread across the heart of the celebrated Côte de Beaune, which is to many the home of the world's finest Pinot Noir. You can taste their expertise in this light, elegant red Burgundy. Expect enticing aromas of raspberry, cherry and liquorice, with elegant tannins.</i>		
208 Domaine Belland, Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru	2019	85
<i>A deep bright ruby colour, with a hint of purple wine, on the nose there are complex fragrances of red fruits, undergrowth and grilled almonds. An extremely delicate rich winy flavour. Elegance and finesse are the dominating characters.</i>		

France - Burgundy Continued Vintage Bottle

249 Chambolle-Musigny, Henri de Villamont **2019** **120**

The red-cherry aromas of this wine almost have a floral note and a slight touch of toasty oak. The subtle theme continues on the palate where the concentrated fruit is fresh and finely drawn, held in place by taut, ripe, fine tannins and brightened by freshness.

209 Vosne-Romanée, Jean Fery & Fils **2018** **165**

An elegant expression of Pinot Noir, showing flavours such as raspberry, strawberry, plum and liquorice and cardamon. Over time it has developed earthy notes such as mushroom and leather. There is a gentleness to the wine and a beautiful long finish.

France - Beaujolais

210 La Madone Fleurie, George Dubeouf **2020** **43**

An elegant Fleurie with subtle floral aromas surrounding a core of deep red fruits. The palate is full of finesse, with a rich and silky texture and an attractive hint of bitter cocoa on the finish. Great served just under room temperature.

France - Bordeaux

211 La Chapelle de Haut-Bages, Pauillac **2016** **68**

La Chapelle, the second wine of Château Haut-Bages Libéral, is sourced from the estates younger vines and offers a fruit-forward, accessible style of Pauillac perfectly suited for early drinking. On the palate La Chapelle de Haut-Bages Libéral expresses flavours of juicy cassis and blackberry as well as discreet hints of liquorice and chocolate with a long supple finish.

212 Château Prieure-Lichine, Margaux **2011** **85**

This Grand Cru Classé of Château Prieuré-Lichine expresses the fine character of its terroir with great respect. With black cherry, plums, spice and an earthy character to finish things off.

213 Château La Tour de By, Medoc **2009** **95**

La Tour de By offers an array of cedar infused dark fruits with a nose of tobacco. The concentrated fruits add a lovely balance alongside the sturdy tannins. This wine has opened up in recent years and it is the perfect time to drink.

214 Château Batailley, Pauillac, 5ème Grand Cru Classé **2016** **98**

With bright and ripe dark fruit on the nose and nice depth. Better still on the palate. You will find ripe fruit, notes of graphite and spice along with ripe, melting tannins. Showing very well now, this will continue to give pleasure for many years to come.

<i>A very fine Berliquet. With a dark ruby colour. This wine offers dense and saturated black cherry notes mixed in with sweet spices, tobacco and liquorice. Drinking very well this full-bodied wine has smooth tannins to finish things off.</i>			
217	La Croix de Beaucaillou, Saint-Julien	2004	135
<i>Dark crimson in colour. This opulent wine displays luscious dark cherries and berries. Over time it has developed a lovely earthiness that doesn't vanish on first sip. The soft tannins make this an easy drinking Saint-Julien that doesn't miss the mark.</i>			
218	Chateau Rauzan-Segla, Margaux	2017	145
<i>A very fine Margaux. The 2017 vintage was known for its perfumed lavender aroma and true finesse. This is what Margaux is meant to be. Alongside dried plums, cassis, cigar smoke and lavender this wine delivers everything it should do and more.</i>			
219	Domaine de Chevalier, Pessac-Leognan, Grand Cru Classé	2001	160
<i>Medium to deep ruby-red color. The nose is dominated by aromas of ripe but fresh red & black fruits that are of medium intensity. Ripe blackcurrant fruit is of mid-weight with an elegant yet supple structure supported by fresh acidity. Alcohol is balanced & a long, classic finish shows toasty, cedary oak notes & leafy hints.</i>			
220	Château Smith Haut Lafitte, Pessac-Leognan, Grand Cru Classé	2014	165
<i>The palate is medium bodied with a soft and mellow opening. Quite spicy in the mouth with leather-tinged fruit on the open and inviting finish, there is something very approachable about this Smith-Haut-Lafitte, though like the 2014 Pape-Clement, it contains the substance to drink well over 10-15 years.</i>			
221	Château Ducru-Beaucaillou, St-Julien, 2ème Grand Cru Classé	1996	250
<i>The 1996 Ducru-Beaucaillou is a blend of 75% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25% Merlot. Medium brick coloured, it delivers mature notes of sweaty leather, tobacco and dried mulberries with a core of kirsch, charcuterie and dried cranberries plus a waft of sandalwood. Medium-bodied, the palate has fantastic freshness with a light chewiness to the texture and loads of herbs spark red and black fruits, finishing earthy.</i>

<i>Lots of intense, fresh fruit in the palate, masterfully blended to create unusual balance and finesse in a wine at this price. Plenty of ripe plum and soft fleshy fruit, with a medium body and velvet finish.</i>			
223	Châteauneuf du Pape, Clef Des Papes	2019	59
<i>A single estate and fully matured wine from the most well-known appellation of the southern Rhone valley, this wine is rich, full-bodied and spicy with a lovely sweet mid-palate and soft tannins to finish. Very low yields explains why these famous wines, produced mainly from Grenache grape, age so beautifully.</i>

225	Le Vieux Télégraphe, Châteauneuf du Pape	2010	120
<i>The 2010 Vieux Télégraphe Chateauneuf du Pape is saturated with notes of kirsch, raspberry, liquorice, Provencal herbs, nori and pepper. With good acidity and a full body this wine is drinking very nicely.</i>			
226	Domaine Du Grand Mayne Cuvée Millennium, Côtes De Duras (DOUBLE MAGNUM)	2000	195
<i>A stunning vintage which produced great wines with opulent character, freshness and purity from every red Bordeaux wine appellation. This is the type of vintage Bordeaux lovers can never have enough of in their cellars.</i>			

Greece

227	Thymiopoulos, Jeunes Vignes de Xinomavro, Noussa	2021	36
<i>Gorgeous bright scarlet shade in the glass; red fruit aromas of cherry, raspberry and strawberry, with a hint of creme de framboise and something like rhubarb... The palate is fresh and savoury, delicate red cherry framed by a mineral smoky character. Finishes with the merest hint of tannin, but this is remarkably light and bright for Xinomavro.</i>			

India

228	J'Noon, Fratelli Vineyards, Maharashtra	2021	79
<i>J'Noon is a joint venture between Kapil Sekhri of Fratelli wines and Jean-Charles Boisset who wanted to produce India's finest wine. The word 'Junoon' comes from a French take on the 'Urdu' word meaning 'passion'. Quarles Harris is one of the oldest Port Houses. It was established in 1680 by Thomas Dawson and over three centuries, has built an outstanding reputation for the quality of its Ports. There are written records dating back to 1689 for a shipment of 98 pipes of Port, which is the oldest recorded shipment by a firm still trading today. Quarles Harris 1977 Vintage Port is perfect for drinking now and is a great example of what a fully mature Vintage Port should be. Drink now to 2030. Healthy ruby with a brick rim. Quite subtle already, there is some perceptible evolution of colour and flavour here. Mineral rather than fruit flavours dominate. Very big and full.
