White Wines

Argentina

- 101 Masi Tupungato, Pinot Grigio/Torrontes, Passo Blanco 2023 35**
An organic Argentinian wine made with Italian flair. The Passo Blanco displays aromas of flowers and ripe fruit, peaches and dried apricots. The palate is fruity and refreshing with good acidity and hints of lemon.

Austria

- 105 Rudi Pichler, Grüner Veltliner Federspiel 2022 49**
An Austrian classic! Notes of citrus, green apple and stone fruits. Well balanced acidity leading to a spicy, lively wine with beautiful minerality and elegance.

Australia

- 111 Deakin Estate, Chardonnay, Victoria 2023 34**
An easy going classic Australian Chardonnay, juicy notes of peach and lemon blossom, a creamy slather of vanilla with a crisp refreshing finish.
- 112 Langmeil Wattle Brae, Dry Riesling, Eden Valley 2023 44**
A zippy dry riesling that displays zesty lime and tropical fruits. Granny smith apples sing together with the lime and the floral blossom.
- 113 Protero "Aromatico", Adelaide Hills 2022 55**
A lovely Australian take on a Northern Italian blend made with 71% Gewürztraminer, 27% Riesling and 2% Sauvignon Blanc. With aromatic notes of Rose, Citrus and freshly baked yeasty bread this wine is brought together to have a clean long finish.

Croatia

- 120 Matošević Alba, Malvazija Istarka, Istria 2023 46**
Made from 100% local Istrian Malvazija grapes, this wine has a pronounced golden colour with delicate aromas of green apple, white peach, and wildflowers. The palate is refreshing with flavours of citrus, honey, and minerals, balanced by a crisp acidity and a long finish.

France

- 130 Domaine La Prade, Sauvignon Blanc, Languedoc 2023 31**
A crisp, lively Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of green apple, pink grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is dry and refreshing, with a rounded mid-palate and an elegant finish.
- 131 Luvignac, Picpoul de Pinet St Clair, Languedoc 2023 36**
Coming from the small village in the south of France 'Pinet' This wine has elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, with a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.
- 132 Mas La Chevaliere, Viognier, IGP, Languedoc 2023 38**
This Viognier has beautiful aromas of ripe pear and fresh stone fruit. On the palate there are delicate flavours of elderflower and peach.

133 Gewurztraminer Orchidées Sauvages, Muré, Alsace 2022 40

The slightly sweet wine has an oily, mouthcoating feel, with a welcome stemmy bitterness that creates a nice balance with the bracing acidity, steely citrus aromas, and hints of Pineapple and residual sugar.

134 Domaine Chantelain, Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley 2023 49

Notes of citrus fruits and exotic fruits (lemon, pink grapefruit, pineapple) as well as mineral aromas (flint) typical of the appellation. The mouth is very round with exotic and mineral notes, associated with a very nice and long finish.

135 Domaine Cherrier, Sauvignon Blanc, Sancerre 2023 57

Hailing from a third-generation winemaker, this Sancerre house was established in 1927. You will find notes of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.

136 Domaine Hamelin, Chablis 1er Cru, Vau Ligneau 2022 62

This wine is an overachiever, it shows the captivating mineral quality in the palate that true Chablis should have. It is both fleshy and full while retaining fresh orchid fruit and a zesty finish.

137 Michel Bouzereau, Mersault, Les Grands Charrons 2022 104

Refined, delicate Meursault showing smoky, nutty aromas, and then a powerful, citrusy palate. Bright and invigorating – a great example of the modern Meursault style.

138 Louis Latour, Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru, La Garenne 2019 138

The vineyard of La Garenne is in the heart of a cluster of the finest Premier Crus from Puligny-Montrachet. The wine shows an intense nose with aromas of honeysuckle, vanilla and silex. On the palate white fruits match perfectly with the delicious notes of almond paste and vanilla. The wine is rich and opulent with a focused 'goût de terroir'.

139 Xavier Monnot, Mersault 1er cru, Les Charmes 2021 178

Swirls of smoke and caramelized honey accent white blossom and pear in this fresh-fruited, zesty but opulent white. Tart pineapple and lemon flavors pierce on the midpalate but finish with a delicate kiss of vanilla.

Greece

150 Thymiopoulos, Malagouzia & Assyrtiko, Noussa 2023 37

The perfect marriage of the rich stone fruit and floral flavours of Malagouzia with the acidity and minerality of Assyrtiko, which adds freshness and complexity to the finish.

Italy

156 Mezzacorona, Terre de Noce, Pinot Grigio, Trentino 2023 30

This wine is characterised by zippy citrus fruits and it's pale straw-yellow colour. With hints pears and apples, fresh notes of honeysuckle, crisp acidity and a refreshing aftertaste.

<i>Tropical notes of mango and papaya combine beautifully with hints of jasmine and acacia flowers. Refreshing, yet opulently textured, this Grillo offers real pleasure and an elegance rarely seen in this variety.</i>		
158 Villa Bianchi Verdicchio, CdJ Class Umani Ronchi	2023	35
<i>The bouquet is fine and intense, fruity and floral. On the palate, the wine demonstrates a pleasant structure based on vibrant and fresh notes, followed by a typically almond aftertaste.</i>		
159 Broglia, Gavi di Gavi La Meirana, Cortese	2021	46
<i>Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.</i>		
160 Vette di San Leonardo, Sauvignon Blanc, Trentino-Alto	2022	51
<i>A wonderful Sauvignon Blanc coming from northern Italy. Slightly reminiscent of a new world Sauvignon Blanc, this wine packs a punch of white peaches, citrus, gooseberry, passionfruit and fresh sage all bound together with a clean minerality on the finish.</i>		
161 Antinori, Bramito della Sala, Chardonnay, Umbria	2022	54
<i>The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine, with a tautly structured palate and aromas of apples, citrus and toast.</i>		
162 Antinori, Cervaro della Sala, Umbria	2022	110
<i>Critics have rated this as the best available among Umbria wines. Cervaro della Sala 2022 exhibits a delicate straw-yellow hue with subtle green undertones. On the nose, there are faint smoky traces of cedar and flint, accompanied by floral nuances of Spanish broom and mimosa blossoms. The palate is lively and fresh, marked by flavours of vanilla, lemon butter, and delicate pastries.</i>

165 Conde Valdemar, Rioja Blanco	2023	36
<i>Fresh, intense aromas of fruits and white flowers, dominated by apple and pear nuances. Fruity and fresh on the palate with a crisp finish.</i>		
166 Serra da Estrela, Albariño	2023	44
<i>A straw yellow wine with green reflections. Hints of apricot and pear, ripe exotic fruits are complemented by a lemon lime vibrancy and fresh balanced acidity. All perfectly blended with its subtle flowery scent.</i>		
167 Bodega Agerre, Txakoli, Basque Country	2022	46
<i>A refreshing, dry white wine with zippy citrus flavours of green apples and lemons. With a crisp and balanced acidity, it is complemented by an enticing salty spritz, creating an incredibly aromatic finish. Made from the Hondarrabi Zuri grape, this hidden gem is a delight.</i>		

Red Wines

Argentina

301 Masi Tupungato, Malbec/Corvina, Paso Doble, Mendoza 2022 36

An organic Argentinian wine made with Italian flair. Passo Doble is an aromatic red wine blend of Malbec (85%) and Corvina Veronese (15%). This wine has intense fruitiness and delicious spiciness. The big structure of the wine comes from the Malbec and the vibrant fruitiness comes from the Corvina grapes which are lightly dried, just like they are in Italy.

302 Pulenta Estate, Malbec I, Mendoza 2021 46

A classic Malbec that is very smooth and well balanced. With intense flavours of red fruits such as strawberries and cherries this wine comes together with delicate sweet spices that come from the oak ageing, showing a wine with great character and structure.

303 Pulenta Estate, Gran Corte VII, Mendoza 2020 72

On the nose the wine reveals elegant notes of raspberry, wild strawberry, cocoa and rosemary. The palate is medium bodied with supple tannins. The fruit profile is red rather than black, with a smooth, harmonious texture and attractive notes of cedar and dried orange peel on the finish.

Chile

305 Morandé Pionero Reserva, Pinot Noir, Aconcagua 2022 30

A pure and elegant Pinot Noir with notes of raspberry and gentle spice on the nose. The palate is light and silky in texture, allowing the beautiful summer fruit flavours to shine through.

306 Matetic Carrolilo, Carménère, Colchagua 2022 43

Fragrant and lively, with red berry fruit and hibiscus alongside mocha notes. The classic spice and herbaceous character of this grape come through discreetly on the palate with a smooth and easy-going finish that remains rich in fruit.

France - Burgundy

311 Domaine Cauvard, Chorey-lès-Beaune 2022 51

Three-generations of wine-growing experience is behind this wine. You can taste their expertise in this light, elegant red Burgundy. Expect enticing aromas of raspberry, cherry and liquorice, with elegant tannins.

312 David Moreau, Maranges, Aux Gryphées 2022 64

A pretty mid-purple colour with a light oaking to the nose, but above all a really charming fruit, poised, delivering a great fruit-to-acid balance and a light salinity alongside the fresh raspberry fruit.

313 Louis Latour, Savigny Les Beaunes 2018 69

This Savigny presents a dark ruby hue. The nose is expressive unveiling wild strawberry and spices notes. The mouth offers blackcurrant and liquorice aromas on silky tannins. An elegant wine with a delightful freshness.

314 Vosne-Romanée, Jean Fery & Fils, Pinot Noir	2018	87
<i>An elegant expression of Pinot Noir, showing flavours such as raspberry, strawberry, plum and liquorice and cardamon. Over time it has developed earthy notes such as mushroom and leather. There is a gentleness to the wine and a beautiful long finish.</i>		
315 Domaine Belland, Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru	2019	96
<i>A deep bright ruby colour, with a hint of purple wine, on the nose there are complex fragrances of red fruits, undergrowth and grilled almonds. An extremely delicate rich winy flavour. Elegance and finesse are the dominating characters.</i>		
316 Henri de Villamont, Chambolle-Musigny	2019	120
<i>The red-cherry aromas of this wine almost have a floral note and a slight touch of toasty oak. The subtle theme continues on the palate where the concentrated fruit is fresh and finely drawn, held in place by taut, ripe, fine tannins and brightened by freshness.</i>

319 George Dubeouf, La Madone Fleurie	2022	42
<i>An elegant Fleurie with subtle floral aromas surrounding a core of deep red fruits. The palate is full of finesse, with a rich and silky texture and an attractive hint of bitter cocoa on the finish. Great served just under room temperature.</i>

320 Chateau Montlandrie, Cotes de Bordeaux Castillon	2009	54
<i>Do not ignore this wonderful Cotes de Castillon! It has a beautiful, vibrant bouquet with very expressive Cabernet Franc. The palate is medium-bodied with very fine tannins. There is a real fleshiness here from the Merlot, but the Cabernet Franc completes the picture with the hints of tobacco on the finish. Superb.</i>		
321 Château Cantemerle, Haut Médoc, 5eme Cru Classé	2020	67
<i>Aromas of blackcurrants and kirsch with hints of dried blood orange, liquorice and cocoa. Medium- to full-bodied with layers of well-integrated, finely polished tannins. Structured and toned with a fresh and lively fruit-forward palate, seasoned with spices and dried herbs. Lingering, chalky finish.</i>		
323 Château Laroque Saint-Emilion, Grand Cru Classé	2010	75
<i>On the nose notes of blue fruit, a violet note, and plenty of baked earth. The palate is silky and refined, with a rich and powerful core of fruit, and plenty of acidity and salty minerality to balance it. The finish is long, focussed, and savoury, showing hints of development, but with plenty of life, too.</i>		
324 Château La Tour de By, Médoc	2009	76
<i>La Tour de By offers an array of cedar infused dark fruits with a nose of tobacco. The concentrated fruits add a lovely balance alongside the sturdy tannins. This wine has opened up in recent years and it is the perfect time to drink.</i>

325 Chateau Grand-Puy-Lacoste 'Lacoste-Borie', Pauillac	2012	78
<i>If Xavier Borie's wonderful Grand Puy Lacoste doesn't offer enough value for money, then Lacoste Borie, the highly impressive second wine of this high flying 5th growth Chateau should do the trick! There's subtle and welcoming grilled oak on the nose with smooth brambly fruits and acidity that is present but balanced. The tannins are well integrated with touches of menthol on the finish and a certain restraint that give clues to the appellation.</i>		
326 Château D'Angludet, Margaux	2012	84
<i>Another truly exceptional wine from the Sichel family, the 2012 d'Angludet has a deep ruby/purple color, a sweet floral, blueberry and blackcurrant-scented nose with a touch of licorice, light tannins, low acidity and a nice, fleshy mouthfeel. This is a sexy, mouth-filling and satisfying wine from both a hedonistic and intellectual vantage point.</i>		
327 La Croix de Beaucaillou, Saint-Julien	2004	89
<i>Dark crimson in colour. This opulent wine displays luscious dark cherries and berries. Over time it has developed a lovely earthiness that doesn't vanish on first sip. The soft tannins make this an easy drinking Saint-Julien that doesn't miss the mark.</i>		
328 Château Batailley, Pauillac, 5ème Grand Cru Classé	2017	99
<i>With bright and ripe dark fruit on the nose and nice depth. Better still on the palate. You will find ripe fruit, notes of graphite and spice along with ripe, melting tannins. Showing very well now, this will continue to give pleasure for many years to come.</i>		
329 Chateau Rauzan-Segla, Margaux, 2ème Grand Cru Classé	2017	125
<i>A very fine Margaux. The 2017 vintage was known for its perfumed lavender aroma and true finesse. This is what Margaux is meant to be. Alongside dried plums, cassis, cigar smoke and lavender this wine delivers everything it should do and more.</i>		
330 Château Smith Haut Lafitte, Pessac-Leognan, Grand Cru Classé	2014	145
<i>The palate is medium bodied with a soft and mellow opening. Quite spicy in the mouth with leather-tinged fruit on the open and inviting finish, there is something very approachable about this Smith-Haut-Lafitte, though like the 2014 Pape-Clement, it contains the substance to drink well over 10-15 years</i>		
331 Domaine de Chevalier, Pessac-Leognan, Grand Cru Classé	2001	155
<i>Medium to deep ruby-red color. The nose is dominated by aromas of ripe but fresh red & black fruits that are of medium intensity. Ripe blackcurrant fruit is of mid-weight with an elegant yet supple structure supported by fresh acidity. Alcohol is balanced & a long, classic finish shows toasty, cedary oak notes & leafy hints.</i>

332 Château Léoville-Barton, St-Julien, 2ème Grand Cru Classé	2000	245

This 2000 vintage, is undoubtedly one of the most majestic wines ever made at Léoville Barton, this behemoth displays massive power and structure. A prodigious, saturated purple-colored effort, it boasts layers of concentrated fruit along with notes of graphite, camphor, damp earth, and jammy cassis. Immense, even monstrous in the mouth, it possesses awesome extraction and richness.

France - Côtes du Rhône / Pay d 'OC

337 Domaine La Prade, Merlot, Côtes de Thongue, IGP	2023	31
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A smooth, spicy Merlot with aromas of plums, berries and tobacco. The palate is medium-full and packed with both fruit and savoury flavours.

338 Clef Des Papes, Châteauneuf du Pape	2020	59
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A single estate and fully matured wine from the most well-known appellation of the southern Rhone valley, this wine is rich, full-bodied and spicy with a lovely sweet mid-palate and soft tannins to finish. Very low yields explains why these famous wines, produced mainly from Grenache grape, age so beautifully.

339 Domaine de Thalabert, Paul Jaboulet, Crozes Hermitage	2009	76
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From a world-famous Crozes Hermitage family. This wine displays an explosive bouquet of blackberries, liquorice and sweet cherries, subtle smoky aromas and graphite. A true expression of Crozes Hermitage Syrah.

340 Le Vieux Télégraphe, Châteauneuf du Pape	2011	125
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The 2011 Vieux Télégraphe Chateauneuf du Pape is saturated with notes of kirsch, raspberry, liquorice, Provençal herbs, nori and pepper. With good acidity and a full body this wine is drinking very nicely.

Greece

345 Thymiopoulos, Jeunes Vignes de Xinomavro, Noussa	2021	36
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Gorgeous bright scarlet shade in the glass; red fruit aromas of cherry, raspberry and strawberry, with a hint of creme de framboise and something like rhubarb... The palate is fresh and savoury, delicate red cherry framed by a mineral smoky character. Finishes with the merest hint of tannin, but this is remarkably light and bright for Xinomavro.

India

347 J'Noon, Fratelli Vineyards, Maharashtra	2021	79
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J'Noon is a joint venture between Kapil Sekhri of Fratelli wines and Jean-Charles Boisset who wanted to produce India's finest wine. The word 'Junoon' comes from a French take on the 'Urdu' word meaning 'passion'. With ripe forest fruits and spearmint this wine comes together in such a way you would never guess it is from India.

	<i>This Shiraz offers an abundance of expressive aromas, predominantly of blackberry and plums along with toasty sweet oak. A generous and concentrated palate offers flavours of blackberry, black cherry and plum.</i>		
351	Cantina Valpantena, Torre del Falasco, Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore, Veneto	2019	42
	<i>With juicy notes of dark plums and dried cherries and hints of mocha and chocolate. This full-bodied wine has great structure and is easy drinking.</i>		
352	Antinori, Péppoli Chianti Classico, Sangiovese	2022	47
	<i>The wine is full-bodied wine with plenty of dark cherry and spice flavours, and lovely balancing acidity. The palate has good substance and a lingering, rounded finish.</i>		
353	Antinori Torcicoda, Tormaresca, Primitivo, Puglia	2022	53
	<i>Full body, soft, light acidity but not at all heavy nor syrupy. flavours of ripe blue and black berries, figs, liquorice, herbs and balsamic vinegar. Ripe blueberries driven aftertaste.</i>		
354	Barolo Ricossa, Nebbiolo	2019	59

375 Prunus Dão Tinto **2021** **35**

Lightly oaked and perfectly balanced, with a silky texture and crisp edge. The nose is packed with plums, mulberries, blackberries and anise. On the palate, black cherry and raspberry fruit tones with creamy and chocolaty oak flavours.

1996 was a high-quality vintage with rich and concentrated wines. A stunning Sauternes which is floral on the bouquet with ripe satsumas, burnt honey and caramelised pear, very smooth and luscious.

Port

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A great alternative to white port! Lots of fruit – sweet orange and dried stone fruits with a hazelnut and almond nuttiness provided by 7 years of ageing. This is definitely a sweet desert wine but is well balanced with caramel and biscuit notes.

410	Quarles Harris Vintage Port	1977	175
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Quarles Harris is one of the oldest Port Houses. It was established in 1680 by Thomas Dawson and over three centuries, has built an outstanding reputation for the quality of its Ports. There are written records dating back to 1689 for a shipment of 98 pipes of Port, which is the oldest recorded shipment by a firm still trading today. Quarles Harris 1977 Vintage Port is perfect for drinking now and is a great example of what a fully mature Vintage Port should be. Healthy ruby with a brick rim. Quite subtle already, there is some perceptible evolution of colour and flavour here. Mineral rather than fruit flavours dominate. Very big and full.

Sake

411	Yamatogawa Shuzo, Yauemon “Moonlight” Nigorizake, Fukushima	NV	60
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Moonlight is superb example of a full-flavoured, sweet nigori (cloudy) sake from Yamatogawa Shuzo. Nigorizake is made simply by coarse-filtering fermented sake to only partially remove the rice lees from the mixture. This results in a sake with a dense mouthfeel, a heady fragrance and a delicious, rice-forward sweetness from the remaining lees. Moonlight is full-bodied and weighty on the palate with high acidity and amino acidity elegantly balanced with the sweetness of the residual rice. Matches perfectly with our Thai Curry Ice Cream.
