White Wines

Australia

101 Deakin Estate, Chardonnay, Victoria **2024** **36**

An easy going classic Australian Chardonnay, juicy notes of peach and lemon blossom, a creamy slather of vanilla with a crisp refreshing finish.

102 Riesling, Rieslingfreak No.33, Clare Valley **2025** **45**

The wine is made in a generous and refreshing fruit driven style with a soft, velvety palate of exceptional length. It has classic flavours of ripe lemon and lime and some tropical fruit notes. It drinks well young.

103 Protero "Aromatico", Adelaide Hills **2023** **55**

A lovely Australian take on a Northern Italian blend made with 71% Gewürztraminer, 27% Riesling and 2% Sauvignon Blanc. With aromatic notes of rose, citrus and freshly baked yeasty bread, this wine is brought together to have a clean long finish.

Austria

105 Rudi Pichler, Grüner Veltliner Federspiel **2024** **52**

An Austrian classic! Notes of citrus, green apple and stone fruits. Well balanced acidity leading to a spicy, lively wine with beautiful minerality and elegance.

Croatia

120 Matošević Alba, Malvazija Istarka, Istria **2024** **48**

Made from 100% local Istrian Malvazija grapes, this wine has a pronounced golden colour with delicate aromas of green apple, white peach, and wildflowers. The palate is refreshing with flavours of citrus, honey, and minerals, balanced by a crisp acidity and a long finish.

France

130 Domaine La Prade, Sauvignon Blanc, Languedoc **2024** **34**

A crisp, lively Sauvignon Blanc with aromas of green apple, pink grapefruit and elderflower. The palate is dry and refreshing, with a rounded mid-palate and an elegant finish.

131 Luvignac, Picpoul de Pinet St Clair, Languedoc **2024** **37**

Coming from the small village in the south of France 'Pinet' This wine has elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, with a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.

132 Mas La Chevaliere, Viognier, IGP, Languedoc **2024** **39**

This Viognier has beautiful aromas of ripe pear and fresh stone fruit. On the palate there are delicate flavours of elderflower and peach.

133 Gewurztraminer Orchidées Sauvages, Muré, Alsace **2022** **43**

The slightly sweet wine has an oily, mouthcoating feel, with a welcome stemmy bitterness that creates a nice balance with the bracing acidity, steely citrus aromas, and hints of Pineapple and residual sugar.

<i>Notes of citrus fruits and exotic fruits (lemon, pink grapefruit, pineapple) as well as mineral aromas (flint) typical of the appellation. The mouth is very round with exotic and mineral notes, associated with a very nice and long finish.</i>		
135 Domaine Cherrier, Sauvignon Blanc, Sancerre	2024	60
<i>Hailing from a third-generation winemaker, this Sancerre house was established in 1927. You will find notes of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.</i>		
136 Domaine Hamelin, Chablis 1er Cru, Vau Ligneau	2023	69
<i>This wine is an overachiever, it shows the captivating mineral quality in the palate that true Chablis should have. It is both fleshy and full while retaining fresh orchid fruit and a zesty finish.</i>		
137 Louis Latour, Montagny 1^{er} Cru, La Grande Roche	2022	79
<i>Bright, expressive and beautifully poised. White blossom and crisp orchard fruit lead into a gentle citrus core, with that subtle salty edge that makes good white Burgundy so moreish. Fresh, polished and effortlessly food-friendly.</i>		
137 Jean Monnier, Meursault, Clos Du Cromin	2022	99
<i>Everything you hope Meursault will be. Gentle toasted hazelnut and a touch of smoke on the nose, then ripe citrus and soft orchard fruit on the palate. Creamy, rounded and quietly powerful, but still fresh and lifted. Proper white Burgundy.</i>		
138 Joeseoph Drouhin, Puligny-Montrachet	2020	128
<i>From one of Burgundy's most respected and historic houses, this is beautifully judged Puligny. White blossom and ripe citrus lead into pear and lemon zest on a silky, rounded palate. There's nothing showy here – just precision, balance and that clean, gentle saline finish that defines great Puligny. Elegant, assured and unmistakably classy.</i>		
139 Xavier Monnot, Mersault 1er cru, Les Charmes	2022	185
<i>Swirls of smoke and caramelized honey accent white blossom and pear in this fresh-fruited, zesty but opulent white. Tart pineapple and lemon flavors pierce on the midpalate but finish with a delicate kiss of vanilla.</i>

<i>The perfect marriage of the rich stone fruit and floral flavours of Malagouzia with the acidity and minerality of Assyrtiko, which adds freshness and complexity to the finish.</i>

<i>Great texture and precision, with distinctive greengage and almond notes on the palate. Fresh and dry, this is particularly characterful Gavi.</i>

<i>A wonderful Sauvignon Blanc coming from northern Italy. Slightly reminiscent of a new world Sauvignon Blanc, this wine packs a punch of white peaches, citrus, gooseberry, passionfruit and fresh sage all bound together with a clean minerality on the finish.</i>

<i>The baby brother of the iconic Cervaro della Sala is an exceptional wine, with a tautly structured palate and aromas of apples, citrus and toast.</i>		
162 Antinori, Cervaro della Sala, Umbria	2022	127
<i>Critics have rated this as the best available among Umbria wines. Cervaro della Sala 2022 exhibits a delicate straw-yellow hue with subtle green` undertones. On the nose, there are faint smoky traces of cedar and flint, accompanied by floral nuances of Spanish bloom and mimosa blossoms. The palate is lively and fresh, marked by flavours of vanilla, lemon butter, and delicate pastries.</i>

<i>Produced in a fuller, riper, and softer style that develops well, this wine is clean, fresh and tropical, it is a full-bodied white with notes of guava, passion fruit, and lemon zest. Its crisp acidity is balanced with an intense mineral finish.</i>

<i>Classic, pungent, herbaceous bouquet of pink grapefruit, tropical fruit, apple and fresh herbs. Equally urgent on the palate, with high acidity and flavours of passion fruit, pineapple, basil, white peach, hay and stony minerality. Fresh, crunchy texture and a lengthy finish</i>

201 Domaine Coste Rosé, Grenache, Languedoc	2024	34
<i>Palish pink in colour, with a plump, dry palate and flavours of strawberry and blackberry. Fresh and round with good length.</i>		
202 Château La Coste, Lady A, Provence	2024	45
<i>An iconic rose with the butterfly designed label by Damian Hurst. This is a delicious, thirst quenching rosé - yet delicate and elegant. Pale in colour, it is light, crisp and zesty, offering flavours of citrus, pink grapefruit, peach and raspberry with a long and refreshing finish.</i>		
204 Caves D'Esclans, Whispering Angel, Provence	2024	48
<i>Pale and dry, with delicate notes of white peach, strawberry and citrus zest. Light in texture, balanced and refreshing, finishing clean with a subtle mineral edge.</i>		

205 Château Marguerite, Château Symphonie, Provence	2024	56
<i>Pale salmon-pink hue. Aromatic nose of white peach, wild strawberry and citrus zest with hints of rose and Mediterranean herbs. A bright, saline freshness with a poised, dry finish with a gentle grapefruit-pith bitterness for lift. Balanced and elegant - a definite favourite of Beth's!</i>

206 Mezzacorrone, Terre del Noce, Pinot Grigio Blush, Trentino	2024	32
<i>The appealing pale blush colour of this wine is obtained from the skins of the Pinot Grigio grapes which are pink in colour. A fresh and fruity wine with a delicate flavour and an off-dry finish.</i>		

Red Wines

Argentina

300 Masi Tupungato, Malbec/Corvina, Passo Doble, Mendoza 2023 38

An organic Argentinian wine made with Italian flair. Passo Doble is an aromatic red wine blend of Malbec (85%) and Corvina Veronese (15%). This wine has intense fruitiness and delicious spiciness. The big structure of the wine comes from the Malbec and the vibrant fruitiness comes from the Corvina grapes which are lightly dried, just like they are in Italy.

301 Pulenta Estate, Malbec I, Mendoza 2022 47

A classic Malbec that is very smooth and well balanced. With intense flavours of red fruits such as strawberries and cherries, this wine comes together with delicate sweet spices that come from the oak ageing, showing a wine with great character and structure.

302 Pulenta Estate, Gran Corte VII, Mendoza 2021 84

On the nose the wine reveals elegant notes of raspberry, wild strawberry, cocoa and rosemary. The palate is medium bodied with supple tannins. The fruit profile is red rather than black, with a smooth, harmonious texture and attractive notes of cedar and dried orange peel on the finish.

Australia

303 Langmeil, Hangin' Snakes Shiraz, Barossa Valley 2023 42

From one of the Barossa's most respected old-vine estates, this is Shiraz with polish. Dark plum and mulberry lead the way, followed by blueberry and a lift of violet from the small addition of Viognier. The palate is generous but not heavy – there's depth and ripeness, yet the tannins are smooth and composed, carrying spice and dark fruit through to a long, savoury finish. Powerful, but beautifully controlled.

304 Yarra Yering, Underhill Shiraz, Yarra Valley 2016 78

A benchmark estate and multiple Australian Winery of the Year, Yarra Yering crafts Shiraz with clarity and tension. 2016 shows black cherry, plum and violet wrapped in pepper, clove and a fine mineral line. Powerful but impeccably structured, with silky tannins and a finish that lingers with savoury spice. Serious, age-worthy and beautifully composed.

Chile

305 Morandé Pionero Reserva, Pinot Noir, Aconcagua 2023 33

A pure and elegant Pinot Noir with notes of raspberry and gentle spice on the nose. The palate is light and silky in texture, allowing the beautiful summer fruit flavours to shine through.

306 Matetic Carrolilo, Carménère, Colchagua 2024 46

Fragrant and lively, with red berry fruit and hibiscus alongside mocha notes. The classic spice and herbaceous character of this grape come through discreetly on the palate with a smooth and easy-going finish that remains rich in fruit.

<i>Another star from Georges Dubeouf. Fragrant and lifted, with violet and peony over a core of ripe cherry and raspberry. Silky and finely textured, it carries its fruit with real finesse, finishing with a gentle savoury edge and a touch of cocoa. Elegant, expressive and beautifully balanced. Best served just below room temperature.</i>		
France - Bordeaux		
320 Chateau Teyssier, Montagne Saint-Émilion	2019	39
<i>From a historic Right Bank estate that has seen substantial investment and careful vineyard work over recent decades, this 2019 delivers classic Saint-Émilion poise with approachable depth. Aromas of blackberry, plum and gentle spice give way to a medium-full palate where dark fruit carries through with hints of cedar, tobacco and mocha. Tannins are well judged – firm but velvety – and bright acidity keeps the finish lively and balanced.</i>		
321 Château de Pitray, Les Prairies, Castillon Côtes de Bordeaux	2021	48
<i>Deep ruby-red with a lively nose of blackcurrant and subtle black tea aromatics. On the palate it combines ripe dark fruit with cedar and a hint of spice, framed by velvety, graceful tannins and a smooth, balanced structure. Fruit and oak are harmoniously integrated, leading to a polished, lingering finish with fine definition and savoury depth.</i>		
322 Château Pontet Barrail, Bordeaux Supérieur	2005	59
<i>From the celebrated 2005 vintage, one of Bordeaux's finest modern years, this has matured into a beautifully composed claret. Layers of blackcurrant and plum are now joined by cedar, tobacco and a gentle earthy depth. The tannins have softened with age, giving a smooth, harmonious texture while retaining structure and freshness. Classic, evolved Bordeaux with real character.</i>		
323 Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite), Réserve Spéciale	2005	68
<i>From the family behind Château Lafite Rothschild, this comes from the exceptional 2005 Bordeaux vintage. Now beautifully evolved, it shows layers of blackcurrant, cedar and tobacco, with softened tannins and a long, composed finish. Classic claret with genuine pedigree – and a rare opportunity to enjoy a mature Rothschild wine at approachable pricing.</i>		
324 Château D'Angludet, Margaux	2014	84
<i>Another truly exceptional wine from the Sichel family, the 2014 d'Angludet has a deep ruby/purple color, a sweet floral, blueberry and blackcurrant-scented nose with a touch of licorice, light tannins, low acidity and a nice, fleshy mouthfeel. This is a sexy, mouth-filling and satisfying wine from both a hedonistic and intellectual vantage point.</i>		
325 La Croix de Beaucaillou, Saint-Julien	2004	89
<i>Dark crimson in colour. This opulent wine displays luscious dark cherries and berries. Over time it has developed a lovely earthiness that doesn't vanish on first sip. The soft tannins make this an easy drinking Saint-Julien that doesn't miss the mark.</i>

<i>From the excellent 2015 vintage, this classic Pauillac shows cassis and black cherry layered with cedar, graphite and cigar box. The palate is structured and authoritative, with firm yet polished tannins and impressive depth. Powerful, composed and unmistakably Left Bank, finishing long and savoury.</i>		
327	2009	145
<i>A standout year for both Pauillac and the estate, 2009 is widely regarded as one of the finest Batailley vintages ever produced. The nose is rich with ripe cassis, blackberry and warm cedar. The palate is full and plush, showing graphite, spice and beautifully silky tannins. Harmonious, expressive and already drinking superbly, yet with the structure to age gracefully.</i>		
328 Château Chasse-Spleen, Moulis-en-Médoc, Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel	2009	110
<i>A standout vintage from this much-admired estate, the 2009 Chasse-Spleen offers a beguiling bouquet of ripe blackcurrant, plum and cedar, layered with hints of mocha and graphite. On the palate, the generous, concentrated fruit is beautifully balanced by polished tannins and a fresh lift of acidity. Now fully mature, it delivers depth and complexity with a long, savoury finish – an elegant expression of Moulis at its peak.</i>		
329 Château Langoa Barton, Saint-Julien, 3ème Grand Cru Classé	2005	118
<i>From the outstanding 2005 vintage, this Third Growth Saint-Julien is now entering a beautiful stage of maturity. Deep cassis and black cherry sit alongside cedar, graphite and fine cigar-box notes. The structure remains firm and composed, but the tannins have softened into a polished, seamless texture. Powerful yet impeccably balanced, with a long, savoury finish. A serious, classically styled Left Bank claret with real pedigree.</i>		
330 Domaine de Chevalier, Pessac-Leognan, Grand Cru Classé	2001	155
<i>Medium to deep ruby-red color. The nose is dominated by aromas of ripe but fresh red & black fruits that are of medium intensity. Ripe blackcurrant fruit is of mid-weight with an elegant yet supple structure supported by fresh acidity. Alcohol is balanced & a long, classic finish shows toasty, cedary oak notes & leafy hints.</i>		
331 Château Léoville-Barton, St-Julien, 2ème Grand Cru Classé	2000	245
<i>This 2000 vintage, is undoubtedly one of the most majestic wines ever made at Léoville Barton, this behemoth displays massive power and structure. A prodigious, saturated purple-coloured effort, it boasts layers of concentrated fruit along with notes of graphite, camphor, damp earth, and jammy cassis. Immense, even monstrous in the mouth, it possesses awesome extraction and richness.</i>

<i>A single estate and fully matured wine from the most well-known appellation of the southern Rhone valley, this wine is rich, full-bodied and spicy with a lovely sweet mid-palate and soft tannins to finish. Port

A great alternative to white port! Lots of fruit – sweet orange and dried stone fruits with a hazelnut and almond nuttiness provided by 7 years of ageing. This is definitely a sweet desert wine but is well balanced with caramel and biscuit notes.

410 Quarles Harris Vintage Port 1977 175

Quarles Harris is one of the oldest Port Houses. It was established in 1680 by Thomas Dawson and over three centuries, has built an outstanding reputation for the quality of its Ports. There are written records dating back to 1689 for a shipment of 98 pipes of Port, which is the oldest recorded shipment by a firm still trading today. Quarles Harris 1977 Vintage Port is perfect for drinking now and is a great example of what a fully mature Vintage Port should be. Healthy ruby with a brick rim. Quite subtle already, there is some perceptible evolution of colour and flavour here. Mineral rather than fruit flavours dominate. Very big and full.

Sake

411 Yamatogawa Shuzo, Yauemon “Moonlight” Nigorizake, Fukushima NV 60

Moonlight is superb example of a full-flavoured, sweet nigori (cloudy) sake from Yamatogawa Shuzo. Nigorizake is made simply by coarse-filtering fermented sake to only partially remove the rice lees from the mixture. This results in a sake with a dense mouthfeel, a heady fragrance and a delicious, rice-forward sweetness from the remaining lees. Moonlight is full-bodied and weighty on the palate with high acidity and amino acidity elegantly balanced with the sweetness of the residual rice. Matches perfectly with our Thai Curry Ice Cream.
